Regional Development Australia Whyalla and Eyre Peninsula (RDAWEP) in partnership with TAFE SA and Regional Transport Training Services (RTTS) are offering **free or heavily subsidised** training courses.



WHAT

40 places are available for **unemployed** or **'under employed'** people.

They must:

- be aged 17 years or over
- not be enrolled in school
- **be unemployed** (i.e. not currently employed AND actively looking and available for work)
VET or university studies do not meet the definition of unemployed.
- **OR underemployed** (i.e. employed but working 17 hours or less per week and wanting to work additional hours)
- be an **Australian OR New Zealand citizen** OR a permanent Australian resident OR live in South Australia and have full work rights with no Visa conditions/restrictions

THE SKILLS.

The following truck licence training will be delivered by Regional Transport Training Services:

- Heavy Combination Truck Licence - you pay \$700
- Multi Combination Truck Licence - you pay \$500
- All other courses are free and delivered by TAFE
