## Forklift Licence

Licence to operate a forklift truck (TLILIC2001)

This unit requires the operator to be able to plan the work, conduct routine checks on the forklift, shift loads in a safe manner and shut down and secure the equipment after completion of operations. This unit is based on the National Standard for Licensing Persons Performing High Risk Work.

The work required in this unit relates to the National Standard for High Risk Work (Enter and work in confined spaces).
